



THE KASAYA FLOODS AS PREDICTED BY WARMA

Kasaya Plains of Mwanzi District experienced extensive flooding as predicted by the Water Resources Management Authority flood forecast model. The floods that hit the area between 14 to 16 January 2022, were moderate to mild due to torrential rains experienced and the swelling of Loazamba River, a tributary of Machile River. There were however no lives lost but many homes were affected displacing many families, animals, and their properties.

On 12 January 2022, the Water Resources Management Authority did predict torrential floods affecting Mwanzi District near the Livingstone-Sesheke Road.
